CURRICULUM RECOMMENDATIONS

We look for applicants who have a strong academic preparation. We recommend that students have completed the following courses in high school:

- English: 4 years
  - Mathematics: 3 years, including Algebra II\*
  - Social Studies: 3 years
  - Laboratory Sciences: 3 years
- \*We recommend four years of mathematics and science for a student considering college study in Business, Chemistry, Mathematics and Nursing.*

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

A completed application for admission should include:

- Common Application and essay
  - Official secondary school transcript or GED scores
  - Two letters of recommendation (from an academic teacher and a school counselor)
  - Interview (Recommended, but not required)
  - SAT or ACT scores (optional)
