CURRICULUM RECOMMENDATIONS

- *We recommend four years of mathematics and science for a student considering college study in Business, Chemistry, Mathematics and Nursina.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

A completed application for admission should include:

- Common Application and essay
- Official secondary school transcript or GED scores
- Two letters of recommendation (from an academic teacher and a school counselor)
- Interview (Recommended, but not required)
- SAT or ACT scores (optional)
